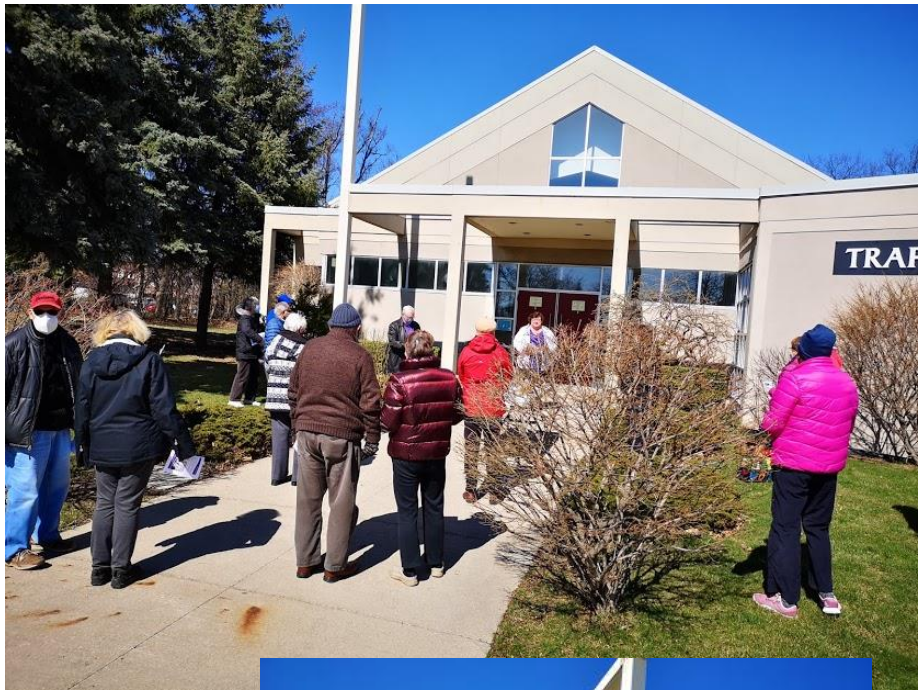
CLOSING HYMN: #274 *Crown him (vs 1-3)*
